AFR County/Local Match Scholarship 2020 Application

Objective:

The AFR state office will match up to \$1,000 per county to allow one or multiple students the opportunity to further their education. This is a voluntary program. Counties will receive top priority. If a county does not take full advantage of the \$1,000 that it is allotted, then locals in that county can assume the balance, if they so choose.

Eligible educational pursuits include university, college, or technical school course work leading to a degree or certification. A digital photograph of the scholarship recipient must be sent to the AFR Youth Coordinator.

Application Guidelines:

1. Applicant or member of applicant's immediate family must be an AFR Insurance policyholder.
 - a. Member of policyholder household – eligible
 - b. At least one parent in split household is policyholder – eligible
 - c. Grandparents of applicant are policyholders and applicant is residing in grandparent's household – eligible
 - d. Other applicant policyholder situations are not eligible, unless granted by AFR Home Office in advance
2. Applicant must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 Grade Point Average on a 4.0 Grade Scale at the time of graduation. To receive the first half of the scholarship (fall semester), student must submit fall semester enrollment of 12 hours or more to the AFR Youth Coordinator. To receive the second half of the scholarship (spring semester), student must have: 1) earned a 3.0 GPA the preceding semester and 2) continued spring semester enrollment of 12 hours or more. If either 1) or 2) above does not happen, the county/local will be refunded the unused half of their original contribution for that specific scholarship.
3. Applicant must be a graduating senior in high school.
4. Applications must be accompanied by an official transcript and a current photograph of the applicant. A digital photograph of the applicant must also be emailed to the AFR Youth Coordinator.
5. Any extenuating circumstance may be appealed to the AFR Home Office, Attn: Youth Coordinator, for review and final ruling in advance.
